Investors who lost their savings in **Earl Jones**'s multimillion-dollar **Ponzi** scheme are planning a musical protest to voice their displeasure with the Royal Bank of Canada.

A group of victims, mostly seniors, will ride a bus from Montreal to the bank's headquarters in Toronto.

There, they plan to sing Christmas carols and present a book outlining the havoc Jones's fraud caused in their lives.

The victims argue the bank is complicit in their loss.

They've launched a class-action suit against RBC, claiming that Jones was able to perpetrate his **Ponzi** scheme for more than two decades "as a result of the Royal Bank's negligence and lack of prudence and vigilance."
